The Doctrine of Christ

The Work of Christ:

We believe that the Son, together with the Father and the Holy Spirit, created all things and continues to sustain all things and will one day make all things new (Hebrews 1:2-3; Revelation 21:5). We believe the sinless Son of God laid down His life (John 10:15-18) as a substitute in order to redeem His people (Romans 5:19). We believe that His death on the cross was and is the only satisfaction for the righteous anger of the Father. Having been put to death in the flesh (1 Peter 3:18), He was buried in a tomb and rose again on the third day, according to the Scriptures (1 Corinthians 15:3-4). He ascended into heaven and sat down at the right hand of the Father (Hebrews 10:12). Jesus Christ is the only mediator between God and man (1 Timothy 2:5), making intercessions for us (Romans 8:34).
